
- **Build emotional connections** that are key for developmental growth.

Your child's teacher will use books, puppets, music and toys to help your child develop the 30 foundational skills connected to emotional, language, physical and cognitive development. As your child grows, the Experience Baby Curriculum helps the teacher individualize the experience and increase the challenge so that your child is constantly learning at his unique pace.





## Beyond Bottles and Diapers: A Full Infant Education Program

Beyond the typical bottle and diaper tracking, you will receive a daily journal where you will see which activities your child engaged with and learn about the skills she gained throughout the day from the purposeful play.

Your child's brain doubles in size during her first year and is at 90% of its adult size by age 5. Research has shown that the quality of a child's experiences in the first few years significantly shapes how their brains develop into adulthood.
